

ANNOUNCEMENT: Handling Procedures for LHR closure, BKK-LHR/LHR-BKK Flight Cancellations'

Dear Travel Partner,

Due to a power outage in the London Heathrow area on 21MAR25, London Heathrow Airport is currently closed. The following flights have been cancelled:

- TG911/21MAR LHR-BKK
- TG916/21MAR BKK-LHR
- TG917/21MAR LHR-BKK
- TG910/22MAR BKK-LHR

The following handling procedures should be adhered to with regards to TG documents issued on affected flights/dates only.

## 1. Reservation changes procedures:

- Authority to change the date of travel within ticket validity (same routing/same RBD) without rebooking fee.
- Notation on the Remark field on the PNR:
  "Involuntary reissued due UN TG910/22MAR LHR closure" (respective of affected flight)

## 2. Revalidate/Reissue procedures:

- Authority to reissue tickets for another TG operated flight on original RBD without reissuing fee.
- If new date result in any fare difference, taxes and/or surcharges, additional amount is payable on reissuing of new ticket.
- Notation on the Remark field on the PNR:
  "Involuntary change due UN TG910/22MAR BKK-LHR LHR closure"
