In response to recent increased Covid-19 infections in Iceland and neighbouring countries, the Icelandic government announced a temporary measurement that all passengers arriving to Iceland must undergo 2 COVID tests. The first is at the border on arrival and the second by the primary healthcare service 4-6 days later. In between the 2 tests, arrivals must go into quarantine. The rule will go into effect on August 19.
