New travel requirements

Effective October 30, 2021, WestJet will implement the federal government's mandatory vaccination policy

for air travellers and will operate as a fully vaccinated company.

Phase I

If your clients are travelling between October 30 and November 29, 2021, they will be required to provide proof of vaccination or proof of a valid PCR test.

Phase II

For travel on or after November 30, 2021, only proof of vaccination for guests 12 years or older, with narrow exceptions, will be acceptable for travel onboard all WestJet-operated flights.

Travel outside of Canada
