

Following the travel restriction that was imposed by the Maltese Authorities in mid-July wherein only fully vaccinated passengers are allowed to travel to Malta, tickets issued under **KM tour operator fares** and which are booked to travel up till 31 August 21, can be either fully refunded or rebooked FOC up till the **31 October 21**, for travel later on and by not later than the **16th October 22** (i.e. last return date). Fare difference applies if rebooking has to be made in a different booking class (RBDs).

In the case of **KM public fare tickets**, Air Malta has a “special emergency rule” which can be accessed by travel agents in all GDSs, and which offers agents/clients the possibility of a free rebooking option up till the **31 October 21**, for travel by not later then **31st March 2022** (i.e. last return date). Fare difference might apply. Consequently clients can be offered the possibility to travel later on, up till the **31st March 2022 latest**, against a free rebooking, otherwise if clients holding Air Malta public fares decide not to travel then ticket refund will be subject to ticket terms & conditions.
